Critical Evidence to Collect After a Commercial Vehicle Crash

Time is your enemy after a truck accident. Evidence disappears, memories fade, and trucking companies begin their defense strategies immediately. This checklist helps you preserve evidence that could make the difference between minimal compensation and the full recovery you deserve.

IMMEDIATE ACTIONS AT THE SCENE (If Physically Able)

- \square All vehicle positions before they're moved
- \square Skid marks, debris, and road conditions
- $\hfill\square$ Traffic signs, signals, and road markings
- $\hfill\square$ Weather conditions and visibility
- \Box Truck's DOT number
- \Box License plates of all vehicles
- \Box Driver's license (photograph if possible)
- Damage to all vehicles from multiple

angles

- \Box Cargo or spilled loads
- \Box Your injuries

Information to Collect

- \Box Truck driver's name and CDL number
- \square Trucking company name and contact info
- $\hfill\square$ Insurance company and policy numbers
- \Box Driver's hours on duty (ask directly)
- \square Driver's origin and destination
- \square Names and contact info for ALL witnesses
- \square Badge numbers of responding officers
- □ Ambulance/EMT company names
- \Box Tow truck company information

Critical Observations to Document

- \Box Did the driver appear tired or impaired?
- \Box Any statements the driver made
- \Box Whether driver was using phone/device
- \Box Strong odors (alcohol, drugs, cargo)
- $\hfill\square$ Driver's demeanor and behavior
- \square Any equipment that appears damaged

WITHIN 24-48 HOURS OF THE TRUCK ACCIDENT

📋 Official Records to Request

- \Box Police accident report
- \Box Your complete medical records
- \Box Ambulance run reports
- \Box Emergency room records
- $\hfill\square$ Traffic camera or red light camera footage
- \Box 911 call recordings
- \Box Commercial vehicle inspection reports

Preserve Electronic Evidence

- $\hfill\square$ Save all text messages about the accident
- $\hfill\square$ Screenshot any social media posts by other parties
- \Box Download dashcam footage immediately
- \square Preserve smartphone location data
- $\hfill\square$ Save all insurance correspondence
- □ Keep all medical appointment confirmations

L Important Calls to Make

- \Box Report the claim to YOUR insurance
- \Box Schedule follow-up medical care
- □ Contact an experienced truck accident attorney
- \Box Alert your employer about injuries
- \square Request a copy of the police report

ONGOING EVIDENCE COLLECTION

Medical Documentation

 \Box Keep all medical bills and receipts

 $\hfill\square$ Document all diagnoses and treatment plans

- □ Track missed workdays
- \square Record pain levels and daily limitations
- \Box Photograph injury progression
- □ Keep prescription records
- \square Document all therapy sessions

\delta <u>Financial Impact Records</u>

- \Box Lost wage documentation
- \Box Out-of-pocket medical expenses
- \Box Travel costs for treatment
- □ Home modification receipts
- \Box Hired help or care costs
- □ Medical equipment purchases

📝 <u>Personal Impact Journal</u>

- \Box Daily pain and symptoms
- \Box Activities you can no longer do
- \Box Effects on family relationships
- \Box Sleep disruption
- \Box Emotional/psychological impact
- \Box Medications and side effects

- ECM (black box) data
- Dash camera footage
- Electronic logging device (ELD) records
- Cell phone records
- Satellite tracking information
- Engine diagnostic data

- Driver's criminal history
- Drug and alcohol test results
- Weather reports
- Traffic studies
- Similar accidents at the location
- Company insurance policies
- FMCSA safety ratings
